

#### **GRACE UMW MEETING JAN. 6**

January 6, 2022, starts a new year for Grace United Methodist Women and we hope to see all of the ladies of Grace at this meeting. January 6 at 10:30 am in the Bullock Activity Center. Snacks will be provided by the Leadership Team and our speaker will be Easton Fitzpatrick with Open Gate.

Open Gate is the public center for the Domestic Violence Shelter and Services, Inc. Come join us and learn of opportunities for helping at the Vintage Value Resale Shops or at the shelter. Also we will hear of plans for Cutting Days on which we will be cutting out and making kits for home sewing of dresses in flannel or corduroy for the young girls of the Methodist Children's Home. We look forward to see each of you on Thursday, January 6.

On Nov 16 the Administrative Council, on recommendation of the Covid19 Task Force, altered Grace's Covid19 safety measures in the following ways:

- Masks optional for full vaccinated folks at the 11am service, Sunday School, and all mid-week gatherings.
- Masks expected for all at the 8:30am service regardless of vaccination status.
- Youth in grades 6 and above who are fully vaccinated can treat masks as optional everywhere but the 8:30am service.
- Youth and children in grades 5 and below are expected to wear masks regardless of vaccination status.
- Children ages 2 yrs and younger should not wear masks.
- Food and drink can now be served self service.
