

#### **Safety Changes In Process**

Final Reminder: Trustees will be making some changes regarding the access to Grace as we look for ways to improve safety of our members and staff. These changes have been approved by the Trustees and Admin. Council.

Along those lines, the following changes will be made:

1. To aid in providing a safer worship service, a sign has been placed on the doors at the back of the sanctuary that say "For safety reasons, these doors will be locked shorty after services begin. Please enter through the Welcome Center doors on 4th St. This is being done to reduce the likelihood of someone entering the sanctuary intending harm. Entry into Grace will be limited to the doors into the Welcome Center where a Trustee on Duty will be able to see who wishes to enter Grace and unlock those doors.

We apologize if this may inconvenience some folks from time to time, but strongly feel this move is in the best interest and safety for all at Grace.

2. The code to enter Grace at the choir entrance will be changed. Too many people and vendors have this code making this access unsecure.

Jerry Cribbs will provide anyone connected with the choir the new code. If you have a need to enter through the choir door, please fill out the request form below and submit it to the office for approval/processing. Final call before we make the change. The goal for these changes is to improve safety for all.
