THE HYMNS WE SING- On this first Sunday of Advent the tunes to the liturgical responses we sing each week will change. Both the Gloria Patri and the Doxology have a Trinitarian structure. We will focus today on what we think of as the "traditional" doxology, *Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow* (tune: *Old Hundreth*) written by Thomas Ken (1637-1711). Doxology comes from the Greek words doxa, meaning glory and logos, meaning word. We sing doxologies to give glory or praise to One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Thomas Ken was orphaned as a child and raised by his sister Anna and her husband Izaak Walton. You may recognize Walton's name because he was the author of "The Compleat Angler", a book on fishing that quickly established itself as a standard work and is still available today. They enrolled Thomas in an all-boys school at Winchester College. Later, ordained as an Anglican priest in 1662, he returned to Winchester as a chaplain. Thomas wrote three hymns to encourage the devotional habits of the boys.

One hymn was to be sung upon waking, another at bedtime, and a third at midnight if sleep didn't come. All three hymns ended with a common stanza, which has become the most widely sung verse in the world: Praise God, from Whom all blessings flow/Praise Him, all creatures here below/Praise Him above, ye heavenly host/Praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

This particular acclamation of praise is one of numerous doxological declarations that appear in many hymns, often in the final stanza. "Of the Father's Love Begotten", "All Creatures of Our God and King" and "Now Thank We All Our God" are familiar to us. The pattern for many mainline Protestant congregations has been to sing the "Gloria Patri", another doxological acclamation, early in the worship service and Ken's stanza at the time of the offertory. The cosmic character of Ken's praise- "all creatures here below" and "above ye heavenly hosts"-calls on the entire cosmos to praise God.
