### Realm phase 2 coming!

Since October, our giving database has been powered by a new version of our ACS software, called Realm. When a donation gets recorded, a digital gift is processed etc., it is all being entered into the giving feature of Realm.

Soon, we will ask that you consider setting up your own account, which will allow you to have access to your own giving record. This is where you could privately see your own donations that have been processed by us, including current gifts or past gifts. This would allow you to get a Year-To-Date giving statement at any time you might need it. It will also allow you to get your statement via email if you choose that option, or tell us you prefer to continue to want statements mailed to you.

The next part of implementation allows for an online directory. For the online directory to be available to you, members will need to set up an account and you would need to "opt in" for the directory to allow for your contact information to be shared.

Once accounts are set up, there will be an app available which will help groups manage their own communications, and easily talk among their own group members. Assistance will be available for this if you need it.

## Furniture Donations Given to 2SHARE

2Share continues to be a partner of repurposing furniture we are no longer using here at Grace. They picked up a blue love seat that was no longer needed, just this



week. If you want to donate gently used items especially beds and other essential furniture to someone in need, 2Share will come to your location to pick them up and make sure they are delivered to a household that will use it. In 2024, 2SHARE delivered to 258 households, a 22% increase over 2023. The organization served some 800 adults and children bringing the total number of those served since inception to approximately 3500 people (nearly 2000 children). Half of the those served in 2024 were single parent households, mostly single moms or grandmoms. The average family size is slightly under 4. In 2024 2SHARE continued to see an increase in single adult referrals, representing 22% of all referrals this past year. Seniors, mostly singles, represented 13% of all referrals and 15% of households served.

Please help spread the word about this great resource in our community.
