Missions

Mother Hubbard's Cupboard is still serving clients on Wednesdays and Saturdays. <u>The number of people served has increased by 17% in the past year!</u> More than 1500 new households have sought food and the average size of a households served has increased.

At this point, there is a *desperate need for cereal*, since it is not being offered in the government food this quarter and the Cupboard cannot buy in bulk due to restrictions on purchases at grocery stores. So it would be very helpful to have donations of boxes of cereal! If you would like to donate some cereal, you can leave it in a labelled bag in the Welcome Center at Grace and it will be delivered! Other donations are still welcome, but this is a current item VERY needed!
