## What's happening at Grace?

Thanks to an anonymous donor, the old metal windows in the older section (Education and Choir wings) are getting replaced! This work is expected to cause minimal disruption, except for noise and blocking some spaces on Grace Street. Planned work will begin on June 30th. We appreciate the gifts to sustain God's church and are overjoyed that this will also help with utility costs.

Also, there is a problem with roots from the Live Oaks along Grace pushing up the pavement on the streets. The uneven pavement is a tripping hazard and unsafe. Crews will be doing some tree trimming this week with oversight from the city arborist. Then, later in July, they will block off the parking spots affected by the roots rather than removing the trees or risking their loss. They have notified us that we will no longer be able to park on the street in this area.
