#### Mother Hubbard's Cupboard update

Mother Hubbard's Cupboard distributes emergency food at 315 Red Cross Street from 12 to 3 pm on Wednesdays and 9 am to 12:00 pm on Saturdays. 411 households received food during the week of May 25th. Please consider making a family donation of canned meat (ex: chicken, tuna, SPAM) this month. Small poptop cans are given to people without shelter. Standard sized cans are given to households with shelter.

Saturday distribution hours are now 9 am-12 pm. There is a small group of regular Saturday volunteers. But more help is needed to keep Saturdays open for food distribution. MHC board is looking for groups willing to commit to one Saturday a month on an ongoing basis. You must be at least 16 years old to volunteer. Then you can select the days each month you wish to volunteer.
