"Seven Last Words of Christ"

..A weekly meditation

Father, into Thy hands I commend my soul.

Luke 23:46

On Good Friday, March 29, the Grace UMC Chancel Choir, accompanied by other musicians, will lead us in worship as they perform Seven Last Words, composed by Théodore Dubois. The seven last words or sayings of Jesus – come from the Gospel accounts of Jesus on the cross. Each week throughout the season of Lent we will reflect on each of the seven words.

The sixth word is **reunion**.

In this word, we hear another prayer and we sit in the tension of Matthew's "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? (Mt 27:46)" and now we hear Jesus pray in Luke's gospel, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit (Lk 23:46)." Jesus's other words from the cross might be considered prayerful, however, Jesus specifically prays to and with the coeternal, first person of the Trinity when he says, "My God, my God,... [and] Father, into your hands..." As he prays from this dreadful, humiliating cross, we now learn to pray prior to passing through the veil of death into the next phase of life eternal with God. Enduring agony, Jesus prays. Imitating our Lord, we pray with and for our loved ones at the time of death, "O merciful Savior, we commend your servant [to you] (Book of Common Prayer, p. 465)."

I remember like it was yesterday, sitting and praying at Dad's bedside as he took his final breaths on this side of the resurrection. He lost the ability to speak a week prior to this moment, and now he was in the ICU, on a ventilator. We thought we were waiting for him to get better and here we were, facing the truth all of humanity faces at some point, death. Without the words of Jesus and the Church I would not have known the words to pray in this helpless circumstance. Over and over, repeating my prayer like a mantra, I prayed, "Into your hands, O merciful Savior, we commend your servant, your child, Ben. In between this repeated prayer, I spoke to Dad, "Go into Peace," remembering that on resurrection day, Jesus pronounces 'Peace' to his disciples (Jn 20:19).

I thought I might be comforting my dying father, and strangely, I became aware that the Father was comforting me in my own suffering.

Thank you, Jesus, for giving us the words to pray, even and especially from the cross.
