"Seven Last Words of Christ"

See, O woman! Here behold thy Son beloved. John 19:26ff

On Good Friday, March 29, the Grace UMC Chancel Choir, accompanied by other musicians, will lead us in worship as they perform Seven Last Words, composed by Théodore Dubois. The seven last words – or sayings of Jesus – come from the Gospel accounts of Jesus on the cross. Each week throughout the season of Lent we will reflect on each of the seven words.

This week's word is relationship.

Even before we knew we were in it, before we had the language to articulate it, we were in relationship. This relationship begins with God saying, "Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness (Gen. 1:26)." From then on, throughout human history, humans have joined together in this relationship.

Through Jesus, this relationship becomes more intimate, as we learn we are children of God (Rom. 8:14), and if we are children, we are brothers and sisters; we are family, in relationship with God and each other. Elsewhere, Jesus looks at his disciples and calls them his brothers and his mother, even as his mother Mary and siblings are outside the door (Mark 3:34). This relationship God makes with us is closer and more cherished than we can imagine. Jesus is willing to give his life to make it even closer.

In what must have been sheer physical agony, Jesus lovingly looks from the cross at his mother Mary and the beloved disciple and reminds them of who they are as family. "Woman, here is your son.' Then he said to the disciple, 'Here is your mother' (John 19:26-27)." Dying on the cross, Jesus forever reminds us we have been claimed by God who desires a deep, close relationship with us, and we are to extend that connection to each other.

Where is God inviting you in this Lenten season into relationship, to grow deeper with God and connect with others, who are God's children?
