The Anchor gathers people experiencing homelessness, and people who are not, to share coffee and breakfast as a community on Sunday mornings. We gather at Anne Bonny's Bar & Grill, a restaurant on a barge in downtown Wilmington, located at 106 S. Water Street. The Anchor sets up, breaks down, and cleans up before the restaurant opens. Volunteers provide a hotcooked breakfast for about 30 people (prepared off site and arriving on the barge at 8:30). The Anchor provides coffee, water, all paper products and utensils. Everyone works together to set up, make coffee, serve breakfast, and clean up. On the second and fourth Sundays of the month, there is a worship service from 9:00-9:45 for those who choose to join (no requirement at all). Thank you so much for your participation and support. Mother Hubbard's Cupboard distributes emergency food at 315 Red Cross Street from 12 to 3 pm on Wednesdays and Saturdays. During the week of May 11th, 374 households received food. Please consider making a family donation of canned fruit this month. Small pop-top cans are given to people without shelter. Standard-sized cans are given to households with shelter.

Beginning June 7th the Saturday distribution hours will change to 9:00am-12:00pm. There is a small group of regular Saturday volunteers. But more help is needed to keep Saturdays open for food distribution. The MHC board is looking for groups willing to commit to one Saturday a month on an ongoing basis.
