

New information management features coming!

Soon, the Grace giving and database system is getting an upgrade. We will transition from our current system, ACS, to a new version called REALM. This decision to go to a Cloud-based system was made because of better security and ease and improvement of information management, (staying in touch with each other). Hurricane Helene Update

The United Methodist Church has been actively providing relief in western North Carolina. In the first week after the storm, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) distributed one million bottles of water. In addition, UMCOR's caring presence has provided free childcare for families of first responders, fed thousands of neighbors, set up charging stations and wifi hotspots, and more.

Response from United Methodist churches around North Carolina and beyond has been tremendous. And Grace's response fits right in. We have collected approximately \$5,000 for hurricane relief, with more money arriving. Grace forwards those funds to UMCOR, where 100% goes directly to storm relief. Grace volunteers have served at the Conference warehouse in Goldsboro, NC preparing cleaning kits for shipment to Western North Carolina, and we are nearly complete with the build out of approximately 20 cleaning kits. With the help of our youth, we will be finalizing the packing of these kits and then will send them to our Conference warehouse. With the completion of these kits, our focus will shift to other efforts.

Looking ahead, we can continue to send money, but we will also prepare to send an Emergency Response Team (ERT). Since all team members must complete ERT training prior to deployment, we are working to schedule a training session and will send an announcement when a date is confirmed.

John Chickering will host a storm response information session (via Zoom) on Tuesday October 15th at 7:00 pm. You can find the link in the Grace Friday Enews.

The session will provide an overview of storm response (including the role of the United Methodist Church), and will describe the work ERTs typically do when deployed.
